Questioning

The symbol to help us remember is:

A Question mark



When readers ask questions and search for answers, they are using comprehension skills and interacting with the text! We want to ask questions before, during, and after reading a story.

Try this at home:

As your child reads a book have him/her ask the following:

- What happened... First? Second? Third?
- What were you wondering about as you read this part?
- Can you show me a part in the book where you didn't understand?
 - What was confusing about it?
